It was with great delight as the new Director Central NSW to have the honour of accepting The Federation Shield on behalf of Newcastle Video Moviemakers Inc. Forty Nine entries were judged by three technical judges and ten audience appeal judges then the marks given a total percentage.

The overall placing's were: 3rd Snapshot 68.89%, 5th Guitar Hero 67.90%, 7th Twenty 12 67.13%, 16th Squib 62.43% and 18th Judgement 61.68%

The highest mark for technical was awarded to Twenty 12 of 78.17%

The members of our club have done us proud to produce videos of this standard and to win this award twice since FAMM Ltd in 2006.

In the last twenty two years of our clubs life we have won this award in 1992, 2004, 2008 and now in 2010

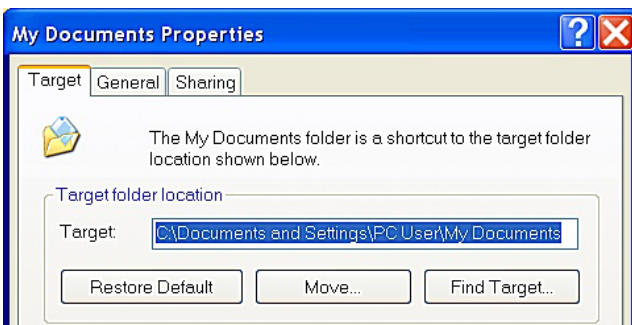
Moving the My Documents Folder ...

The default location for saving most of your data or downloads is the **My Documents** Folder. That can be a lot of data to lose in case of a system crash. The **My Documents** Folder can be Moved to a another **Drive** or **Partition** which is quite easy to do.

Step 1: Right Click on **My Documents Icon** on the **Desktop**, select **Properties**. It will show **Default Target folder location** which is:

C:\Documents and Settings\PC User\My Documents. (PC User is my **Computer Name** and yours will of course be different than mine.)

Step 2:Click on the **Move** button.



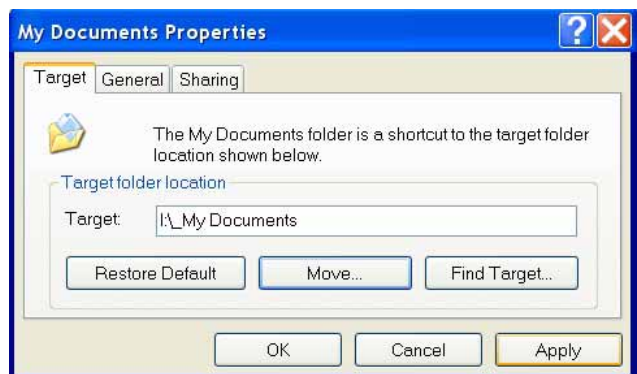
Step 3: Click on **My Computer** and **Browse** to select a **New Destination** for **My Documents** Folder.



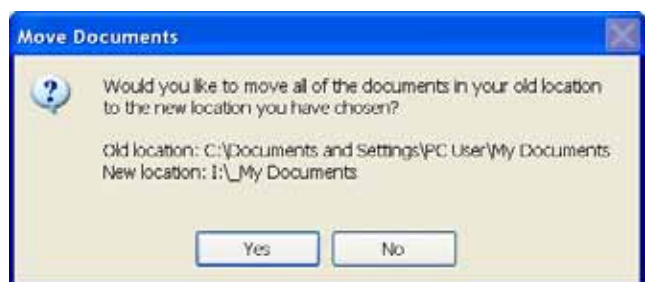
Step 4: Click on **Make New Folder** button and Name it **_My Documents** or any other name.



Step 5: Click on the **Apply** button.



Step 6: Click on the **Yes** button. Be warned as it may take some time depending on how much data there is to move. Once done all data normally saved to **My Documents** will go it the new location.
